





The level of activity of teachers in the weekly surveys:




Average weekly activity level in surveys: 75%

Format of the teaching process throughout the project




General interest of students in the weekly themes

Use of the video from the project consultant












Which of the proposed activities most effectively attracted students this week?








Which of the proposed activities most effectively attracted students this week?






